

ECH Membership Application Guideline – Professors

The ECH accepts membership applications from tenure-track to full professors employed at the University of Vienna from all disciplines who wish to be active in the Hub.

Scientific excellence in the field of environmental and climate research, a strong willingness to actively contribute to the activities and tasks of the Hub, including participation in our two annual retreats, research workshops and outreach activities, are expected.

Please send your expressions of interest to ech@univie.ac.at in one pdf file:

- **Motivation and vision statement** (up to 2 pages):
 - a) How do you envision to contribute to the Hubs goals, mission and in which activities would you like to engage?
 - b) How does your research add to the hub's expertise?
- **Short CV** (up to 3 pages)
 - a) detailing your scientific excellence
 - b) key projects you are involved in and
 - c) 10 most important publications related to the field
 - d) your most significant achievements in the field of Environment & Climate research.

The following criteria will be applied for assessment:

- Academic excellence, including high international visibility and a proven track record in the field of Environment & Climate Research. Academic age will be considered.
- Motivation and vision why you want to be part of the Hub; relevance to the four aspects of the ECH mission stated above (research, impact, reputation, capacity-building)
- Representation of different disciplines and ECH diversity will be considered in the selection.

The directors of the Hub and the Management Board will review and decide on applications biannually. Membership will be granted for three-year terms. As an active member, you can renew your membership for another three years without another application process. If you are an inactive member, your membership will end automatically, but you can simply reapply. If your contract with the University of Vienna ends within the membership period, your membership ends as well.
